ORDER


During the September 15, 2023 Case Management Conference, the Court stated that if the parties sought to provide over 50 pages or 5 documents of extrinsic materials for the Court to consider in ruling on Defendants' proposed Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction, the parties were to create a Joint Record pursuant to the Court's Case Management Order. ECF No. 4. On November 20, 2023, the parties completed briefing on Defendants' Motion. *See* ECF Nos. 27, 28, 29. In the briefing on the Motion, the parties referred to and attached exhibits to their briefs that collectively comprise over 50 pages or 5 documents.

The Case Management Order provides that should a party file a motion for summary judgment, or other substantive motions for which exhibits are relevant, "the parties must submit a single, consolidated record" conforming with the requirements set out in the Order. Case Management Order §§ II.B.2, II.C.1, ECF No. 4. The parties have not filed a Joint Record for the Motion as required by the Case Management Order and pursuant to the Court's direction during the September 15, 2023 Case Management Conference.

Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. Within **7 days** of the date of this Order, the parties shall file a Joint Record in compliance with Sections II.B and II.C of the Case Management Order.
2. Within **7 days** of the date of this Order, the parties shall file corrected briefs on the Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Personal Jurisdiction containing updated citations to the Joint Record. No other changes to the briefs are permitted.
3. The parties are reminded that they are required to file a hard copy version of the Joint Record with the Court within **7 days** of the date of this Order, as provided in Case Management Order § II.B.2.j.
